A Bill was also presented for the sum of Five dollars in
favor of Mr. H. Crubaugh for cleaning Privy on Lot, 5-2 belonging
to J. O. Chapman duly endorsed by Health Officer, & Board of Health
& Pres. of Board of Health. - The Mayor informed that Chapman
authorized the levy to be made against his property & he would pay
it with his tax. - J. W. Bard moved the Bill be accepted

seconded by H. Linwood. Vote ayes Boren, McGirr,
Watson, Linwood & Bard - Carried.

Linwood moved that J. W. Bard be appointed a member of
the committee appointed to have a new Roof put on the City
Prison, to take the place of J. L. Silworth a former Councilman
seconded by John Watson Vote Boren no, McGirr yes
Watson yes, Linwood yes, Bard yes - Carried.
