

Special Meeting, April 19-1880.

Council Chamber, Mt. Union, Ohio.

Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Members present John Watson, J. L. Shunk  
Henry Linwood R. Mc Ginn, Henry Keller and  
Mayor Martin.

The minutes of the preceding meeting  
were read and no objections being raised  
were <sup>declared</sup> adopted. Next came consideration of  
granting Alliance Corporation the privilege  
of hauling earth from the north end of  
Arch Street. Civil Engineer Brooks reported  
that Mt. Union Corporation could spare  
all of the earth down to the established  
grade for 100 feet and half of the earth  
for the next 50 feet. After discussing the  
matter, J. L. Shunk moved that a com-  
mittee of four be appointed to view the  
north end of Arch Street said committee  
to decide how much and in what  
manner the earth should be removed.

Motion seconded by John Watson.
