Regular Meeting:

On motion of J. L. Shunk, seconded by R. McGirr the orders as read were received and the Clerk was instructed to issue orders for the amount of the bills. Vote Ayes, Jno Watson, R. McGirr, Henry Keller, J. H. Bard, Harry Linwood and J. L. Shunk.

On motion of J. L. Shunk, seconded by J. H. Bard, a special ^{levy} of one mill (1) on taxable property, as per valuation on the Grand Duplicate, was made for grading purposes. Vote Ayes, Jno Watson, R. McGirr, Henry Linwood, Henry Keller, J. H. Bard and J. L. Shunk.

The report of the Finance Committee was called for, which is as follows, on the levy of taxes for their respective funds.

On motion of J. H. Bard, seconded by Harry Linwood, the report as above was accepted. Ayes - Geo Watson, J. L. Shunk, Harry Linwood, J. H. Bard, Henry Keller, and R. Mc Girr.

The Ordinance for levying taxes for municipal purposes and providing for its distribution was then read.

On motion of R. Mc Girr, seconded by J. H. Bard, the rules were so suspended as to pass to the second and third readings. Vote - Ayes, Geo Watson, R. Mc Girr, Harry Linwood, J. L. Shunk, Henry Keller, and J. H. Bard. The Ordinance then passed its third reading and on motion of R. Mc Girr, seconded by J. L. Shunk, it was placed on its final passage and ordered to be published.
