On motion of Henry Linwood seconded by Jno. Watson the bills of Melvin Grimes were accepted. Vote Ayes, R. McGirr, Jno. Watson, Henry Keller and Henry Linwood.

On motion of Henry Linwood seconded by R. McGirr the bill presented by Thos. Painter was received and the Clerk was authorized to issue an order for its payment. Vote Ayes - R. McGirr, Jno. Watson, Henry Keller and Henry Linwood. On motion of Henry Linwood seconded by Jno. Watson the Mayor and Clerk were instructed to draw up an ordinance for issuing bonds for borrowing money to defray expenses of grading on Arch Street in anticipation of the levy heretofore made. Vote Ayes, Jno. Watson, R. McGirr, Harry Linwood, Henry Keller and E. C. Bard.

Accordingly the Clerk drew up a copy of an ordinance which was read. On motion of R. McGirr, seconded by Henry Keller the rules were so suspended as to allow the ordinance pass its second reading. Vote - Ayes, Jno Watson, R. McGirr, Henry Linwood, Henry Keller & E. C. Bard. On motion of Jno. Watson seconded by Henry Linwood the rules were so suspended as to allow the ordinance to pass its third reading. Vote - Ayes, Jno. Watson, R. McGirr, Henry Linwood, Henry Keller, & E. C. Bard. On motion of E. C. Bard seconded by Jno. Watson the Ord. was put on its final passage and ordered to be published by posting written copies. Vote - Ayes, Jno. Watson, Henry Keller, Henry Linwood, R. McGirr, and E. C. Bard.

On motion Henry Linwood, seconded by R. McGirr, Dr. A. W. Porter and Jno. Hanning were appointed as members of "Board of Health" for a term of 3 years. Vote - Ayes, Jno. Watson, R. McGirr, E. C. Bard, Henry Linwood, and Henry Keller. On motion of R. McGirr, seconded by Henry Linwood, M. C. Madden was appointed as a member of "B of H." for the term of 1 year to fill a vacancy. On motion of Jno. Watson, seconded by R. McGirr, the Street Commissioner was instructed to proceed with the grading of Arch Street by moving the earth from the front of Mr. Vaughn's property to the hollow near the Coal Shaft of Wm.
