

Council Chamber, May 10 1851. Adjourned Meeting, Mayor Martin in the Chair and members of Council, J. L. Shunk, W. P. Rice, Jos. Preston, J. G. Ernst, and Henry Keller were present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read approved and adopted. On motion of W. P. Rice seconded by J. G. Ernst the Ordinance abolishing the office of Street Commissioner was placed on its second reading. Vote, Ayes - J. L. Shunk, J. G. Ernst, W. P. Rice, Henry Keller and Jos. Preston. The Ordinance was then read.

On motion of J. G. Ernst seconded by Jos. Preston the rules were so suspended as to place the Ordinance on its third reading. Vote, Ayes - J. L. Shunk, J. G. Ernst, W. P. Rice, Jos. Preston, and Henry Keller. The Ordinance was then read.
