

Council Chamber, May 16-1881.

Adjourned Meeting.

Council was called to order with Mayor Martin in the chair, Members of Council present J. L. Shunk, J. G. Earnst, Jos. Preston and W. P. Rice. The minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved, and adopted. The following resignation of H. Linwood was then read.

Mt. Union, O, May 9-1881.

To the Honorable Mayor and Council of the Incorporated Village of Mount Union Ohio; I hereby respectfully tender my resignation as councilman and beg that you take immediate action in accepting the same.

On motion of W. P. Rice seconded by J. L. Shunk, David Hapler was appointed as Councilman to fill the vacancy caused by Harry Linwood's resignation. Vote Ayes - J. L. Shunk, W. P. Rice, J. G. Earnst, and Jos. Preston.

On motion of W. P. Rice, seconded by J. L. Shunk, the Mayor was authorized to employ an engineer to set stakes to the established grade for the new side walks. Vote Ayes - J. L. Shunk, J. G. Earnst, Jos. Preston and W. P. Rice.

Mr. David Hapler was then qualified as councilman.
