On motion of Rice seconded by Shunk the petition from the A. + L. E. R. R. Co. was received and ordered to be placed on file. Vote, Ayes - Rice, Shunk, Keller, Preston - Ernst + Hapsler.

Rice moved and Preston seconded that the Council grant the right of way to the A. + L. E. R. R. through the public streets and alleys of the Corporation. Vote, Ayes - Shunk, Rice, Keller, Preston, Ernst and Hapsler.

Shunk moved and Ernst seconded that the R. R. Co. be requested to cross Main Street east of Postage Street. Vote, Ayes - Shunk, Ernst and Hapsler. Noes - Keller, Preston and Rice. The Mayor decided the motion to be lost.

On motion of Shunk seconded by Preston the Clerk was authorized to notify the A. + L. E. R. R. Co. that the Council had agreed to grant them the right of way through the public streets and alleys without any
