Adjourned Meeting.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor with
the following members of Council present - Rice,
Preston, Hassler, and Shunk.

On motion of Rice seconded by Preston the Ord-
inance granting the right of way to A. & L. E. R. R.
Company was placed on its second reading,
Vote Ayes - Rice, Preston, Shunk & Hassler.

The Ordinance was then read, At this time Ernst
came into the council chamber.

On motion of Rice seconded by Hassler the
rules were so suspended as to place the
Ordinance upon its third reading, Vote Ayes, Ernst,
Rice, Preston, Hassler and Shunk, The ordinance
was then read. On motion of Shunk seconded
by Preston the ordinance was placed upon its
final passage. Vote Ayes - Rice, Ernst, Preston,
Hassler, and Shunk. The Mayor declared the
Ordinance passed. On motion of Rice seconded
by Hassler the Clerk was authorized to publish
the ordinance and to notify the R. R. Co. of
the passage of the same. Vote Ayes - Rice, Ernst,
Preston, Shunk, and Hassler.

The following resolutions were offered by Dr. Rice.

Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated
Village of Mt. Union, O. That R. E. Hudson be
required to construct a new sidewalk in front
of lot No. 15 in Mt. Union, within 60 days; said
walk to be of brick, paving stone or cement, 6 ft.
wide and placed on the established grade of

of the street.

Resolved by the Council that the agent or owner of lot No. 33 in Mt. Union be required to construct a new brick or stone wall within 60 days, to be constructed of brick or stone and placed on the established grade of the street.

On motion of Ernst seconded by Shunk the above resolutions were adopted and the Mayor and Clerk authorized to issue notices and serve them on the owners or agents. Vote Ayes, Rice, Shunk, Ernst, Hassler and Preston.

On motion of Rice seconded by Preston the following resolution was adopted unanimously.

Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Mt. Union, Ohio, that the owner of lot No. 39 (Mrs. Elizabeth Krines) and of Lot No. 64 (Rev. Hilder) be required to construct within 60 days new sidewalks of brick, stone or cement, in accordance with the Ordinance providing for the construction of sidewalks.

On motion of Rice seconded by Ernst the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

Resolved by the Council of Mt. Union, O. that we hereby ~~authorize~~^{require} the following persons to put sidewalks in front of their property on the established grade, viz Mrs. Bush and Shos. Painter; and to be repaired within 15 days from service of notice.

On motion of Hassler seconded by Shunk the Council adjourned. Vote Ayes, Rice, Ernst, Shunk, Preston & Hassler.
