Communication from Horse Co No 1 presenting the name of L. E. Graham for Chief of F. D. was read and on motion of Beardsley seconded by Gray referred to Fire Dept Committee.

Special Committee on Printing of Ordinances through Gray reported that they thought it advisable

That no contract be entered into until after the election of the new Council, when on motion of Beardsley seconded by Vincent the Report was adopted & the Committee discharged.

Mr Coates a member of the Committee also stated that he had an offer from one of the town papers to do all printing of Ordinances &c for nothing if furnished to the paper.
