

Regular meeting May 8th 1872,
Council called to order by the Mayor. Roll
call, members all present, Minutes of last
meeting read and approved.

On motion of J. G. Ernst Secured by
Henry Martin $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mill was levied for
the road fund, $\frac{4}{4}$ Ayes H. P. Rice, Joseph Preston,

On motion of H. P. Rice Secured by Henry
Linwood the levy of $3\frac{1}{2}$ mills for municipal
purposes was ordered and the same to be

 admitted J. Herley Bard to the office of
 Councilman, therefore be it shewed

 ed and directed to procure the necessary
 legal council that may be required in
 the defense of said village and Council,

On motion of J. G. Ernst Sec by Henry Linwood a committee was ordered to be appointed to take charge of town pumps. Ayes. Dr. P. Rice, Joseph Preston, J. G. Ernst, Henry Linwood, Henry Martin ayes none. M. S. Harster not voting. The Mayor appointed on said committee Henry Linwood and J. G. Ernst. On motion Council adjourned.
