

Council Chamber May 14th 1883.

Regular meeting:

Council met and was duly organized by the following Councilmen, appearing with certificates of election and receiving the oath of office from the Mayor in the following order. J. H. Jones, Uryin McGuir, J. St. McAbe, Jas. St. Barnaby. Henry St. Martin the holding over member presented the following remonstrance against the swearing in of John Shaffer a Councilman.
To the Mayor of Mt. Union Ohio.

We the undersigned members of the village Council of Mt. Union Ohio remonstrate with your Honor against the swearing in of Mr. John Shaffer as Councilman for said village of Mt. Union Ohio.

J. St. McAbe, read the following resolution.

Whereas John Shaffer claims to have been elected to the office of Councilman for the village of Mt. Union Ohio at the Spring Election of 1883 to fill an alleged vacancy in the said office of Councilman for the unexpired term of one year, and whereas it is alleged that the said John Shaffer is not entitled to said office and was not legally elected thereto and is not entitled to hold the same,

Therefore be it resolved by the Village Council of Mt. Union Ohio that the said John Shaffer be notified to appear forthwith before this Council at the Council Chamber in said village and show cause why he should not be deprived of acting as Councilman, and to show by what authority he claims to act as such Councilman.

Resolved 2nd that the Clerk of the Council forthwith notify the said John Shaffer of the passage of this resolution. The above resolutions were seconded by Uryin McGuir. The following is vote upon its passage. Ayes. J. St. McAbe, Uryin McGuir, Henry Martin, J. H. Jones, Jas. St. Barnaby.

was now. In accordance with the above resolution, Mr John Shaffer was duly notified of the passage of the above resolution who appeared and stated why he claimed the office of Councilman of Mt. Union Ohio. At this time Rezin McGuire offered the following resolution. Whereas John Shaffer claims to be entitled to sit and act as Councilman for the Village of Mt. Union Ohio for the unexpired term of one year and his right to act as such Councilman has been and is disputed and it appearing that the said John Shaffer has been duly and legally notified to appear before this Council and show cause why he assume to act as such Councilman, and whereas he has been accorded a full and fair hearing in the premises, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Village Council of Mt. Union Ohio, That the said John Shaffer was not legally elected to said office of Councilman and that he has no right to exercise any of the prerogatives of Councilman for said Village, and that he is hereby declared from acting as such Councilman and declared ineligible to hold the same.

Resolved 2nd that we find that John St. Bard was duly elected to said office of Councilman and is legally entitled to hold the same; but that he has been improperly deprived of acting as such; and that in as much as the question of his election is now before the courts:

Therefore be it resolved that the said John St. Bard be and hereby is declared by this Village Council of Mt. Union Ohio to the office of Councilman for said Village to fill the unexpired term to which he was elected in April 1882; and that upon the passage of this resolution the year and days be taken. The above resolutions were seconded by J. St. McAbee.

The following is the vote. Ayes Rezin McGuire, J. St. McAbee, Henry Martin, J. H. Jones, Jas. St. Barnaby. Nays none. John St. Bard was duly qualified as Councilman of Mt. Union Ohio.
