

## Council Rooms Alliance C

Saturday evening April 6. 1878  
 Council convened in Special Session  
 upon Call of Mayor Day, who presided  
 for the purpose of receiving the election  
 Reports and for the transaction of such  
 general Business as required immediate  
 action. Roll called: Members present  
 Miller, Beardsley, Gray, Conter & Vincent  
 Absent: Lusk.

Clerk then stated that having received  
 from the Judges & Clerks the Poll Books  
 & tally sheets he found that the following

& use of all the Rolling Mill Ashes for the  
improvement of the Streets of Alliance O.
