 Village of Alliance is pending in the
 Court of Common Pleas of Stark Co
 Ohio and will be for trial on merits
 at the next term of ^{said} Court.

2nd George Wilber Shidler vs the Incorpor-
 ated Village of Alliance was tried at the
 September term of Court of Common Pleas
 of Stark Co and a judgment for \$2300.
 Rendered against the Incorporation.

The case is now pending for hearing on
 petition in error in the District Court
 of Stark County and will probably come
 on for hearing at the next term of said
 court.

The only Money that have come
 to my hands during the year ending
 April 1st 1878 was \$115 placed in my hands
 to use in buying little on Lots of

 had a lien for side walk lain,
