A Committee of the Board of Health consisting of Mr. O. A. Hartshorn and Jas. A. Turner were introduced and asked the cooperation of the Council in furthering the Sanitary Condition of the village. On motion of J. St. Bard Sec. by Alfred Davis the Street Com. were empowered to finish on Portage street if thought best after proper investigation. On motion of Alfred Davis Sec. by J. St. Barnaby Council Adjourned.
