 Regular Meeting:

Council Chamber.

Council met and was called to order by

The following councilmen were present and answered to their names: J. W. Bard, J. W. Barnaby, Alfred Davis, Sylvanus Miller, Jesse McLean, H. B. Crebaugh.

The mayor being absent on motion of Alfred Davis Sec. by Sylvanus Miller, Councilman J. W. Bard was elected Chairman.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Alfred Davis moved that election bills, clerks bill and Ticket bill be accepted and ordered paid from proper funds; the above was seconded by Sylvanus Miller, an amendment offered by J. W. Barnaby Sec. by Alfred Davis that all bills excepting ticket bill was carried. Ayes J. W. Barnaby, Alfred Davis, J. W. Bard, Sylvanus Miller, Jesse McLean, H. B. Crebaugh. No nays. The original motion as amended was carried by a unanimous vote.

On motion of J. W. Barnaby Sec. by Alfred Davis, the bill for election tickets was accepted and ordered paid from proper funds. Ayes J. W. Bard, J. W. Barnaby, Alfred Davis, Sylvanus Miller, Jesse McLean, H. B. Crebaugh. The Treas. report was then read and on motion of Alfred Davis Sec. by Sylvanus Miller was accepted. On motion of J. W. Barnaby Sec. by Sylvanus Miller, and order was issued for Treas. percentages. Ayes unanimous.

After the minutes were read corrected and approved the Council of 1885 and 1886 adjourned sine die.

Mount Union Ohio April 13th 1886.

Council met in Town House Tuesday evening April 13th 1886. This being first regular meeting after the second Monday in April new Council was organized. Members of Council holding over for one year Sylvanus, Miller and J. F. McLean. New Members elected W. A. Clark, Henry Keller and Joseph Grant; Each for two years, and David Johnson for one year to complete the unexpired term of J. A. Brush (deceased). Members elect presented their Certificates of Election and were qualified and entered upon their duties as Councilmen. In the absence of Mayor McLean Clerk John H. Focht administered the oath of office. Mayor elect Geo. Scott then presented his Certificate of Election and his official Bond which was read by the Clerk, S. Miller. Moved that the Mayors Bond be approved seconded by J. F. McLean, Vote, W. A. Clark yes, Joseph Grant yes, Henry Keller yes, D. B. Johnson yes, S. Miller yes and J. F. McLean yes, carried. Clerk J. H. Focht then administered the oath of office to Mr. Scott and he entered upon his duties as Mayor. Clerk elect J. W. Bard then presented his Certificate of Election and official Bond which was approved by the Mayor. He was then qualified and entered upon the duties as Clerk. Wm. Painter (Marshall) elect presented his Certificate of Election and Bond his bond being approved by the Mayor he was qualified as Marshall. J. N. Turner presented his Certificate of Election as Treasurer and his official Bond which was approved by the Mayor was then qualified as Treasurer. Street Commissioner elect John Mullin presented his Certificate of Election and official Bond the Mayor approved his bond and administered the oath of office to him. Mayor Scott then appointed the Standing Committee for the ensuing year
