Alliance @ April 26. 1878

Council Convened as per adjournment.

Mayor Day presiding Roll called members present Bradsley Probst Trans Ollison Gray absent Cates. The Clerk then read the Bond of Sol Berlin as night Police for \$500 with James Cunningham and J. C. Boecker as Bondsman and on motion of Bradsley and seconded by Ollison the bond was accepted and ordered filed. The Bond of Thomas Johnson as night Police for \$500 with J. Armstrong and J. C. Craven as Bondsman was read and on motion of Gray seconded by Trans was accepted and ordered filed.

The Bond of J. C. Bell Street Commissioner for \$1000 with St. Anderson and John Seft; as Bondsman was read and on motion of Bradsley seconded by Probst was accepted and ordered filed.

After which Mayor Day administered the oath of office to the newly elected officers consisting of J. C. Bell Street Commissioner and Thomas Johnson night Police having heretofore administered the oath to J. C. Pappit City solicitor and Sol Berlin night Police. Mayor Day then

read a communication from the Secretary of the Fire Department stating that at a meeting of the Fire Department held Monday Evening April 22nd 1878 the following officers were recommended to serve the ensuing year, J. M. Webb Chief Engineer. S. G. Hook 1st asst, Capt. McHally 2nd asst, J. D. Miller secretary and John Ramsey Treasurer,
