

Council Chamber Mt. Union Ohio June 15<sup>th</sup> 1886  
 Regular Meeting, Mayor Scott in Chair,  
 Roll Call, Members present, J. F. McLean, Joseph  
 Grant, W. A. Clark, D. S. Johnson and S.  
 Miller, Absent Henry Keller, Minutes of last  
 regular meeting read and approved also min-  
 utes of called meeting May 20<sup>th</sup> read and ap-  
 proved, Mayor Scott offered the following re-

Being appointed a committee of one to see to having  
 \* grade stakes sett for new pavements, and  
 Town Lot cleaned up have attended to the  
 same by getting Mr Stanley to sett the grade  
 stakes and John Conrad to clean up town  
 lot, Side walk notice sent by mail to Mr.  
 Wm. Quetman May 21<sup>st</sup> 1886 and to Mrs  
 Preston May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1886, Side walk notice  
 to J. G. Cherry sent to Standard office Al-  
 liance Ohio for publication June 1<sup>st</sup> 1886,  
 Henry Cook having been elected Cemetery  
 Director for two years took the oath of office  
 May 26<sup>th</sup> 1886, Geo. Scott Mayor.

Clark Moved that the Mayor's report  
 be received and spread upon the records  
 seconded by McLean, carried,

Clark stated that he had seen J. H. Oliver  
 in regard to trimming his shade trees in  
 front of his property and that he desired  
 the Council to have them trimmed pro-  
 perly and he would pay the expense,

Street Committee reported that the Street

Miller moved that all the above bills be accepted except bill of Cantine & Kay, Obey & Love and Street Commissioners bill and the Clerk instructed to issue orders on the Treasurer from proper funds in payment of same seconded by McLean. Vote McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes.

Miller moved that the bill of Cantine & Kay, Obey & Love and Street Commissioners be referred to finance committee seconded by McLean. Carried. On Motion of Clark seconded by Miller the Clerk was authorized to issue an order on Treasurer in favor of S. Garretson for \$39.00 one years interest on Bond. Vote McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes.

Clark moved that an order be drawn on road fund in favor of crossing fund to the amount of lumber used for road purposes that belonged to Street Crossing. seconded by McLean. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes.

On Motion of Clark seconded by Grant the Clerk was instructed to order 500 feet of stringers and 300 feet of plank. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes.

Clark moved that Street Light Committee be instructed to consider the propriety of discontinuing the lighting of street lamps for a time during the short evenings, also the letting of contract for tending same. seconded by Grant. Carried.

Clark moved that the Clerk be instructed to prepare an Ordinance to change the Grade of Portage Street, seconded by Miller. Vote. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes. Clark moved that the Motion to adopt the resolution laid upon the table at last regular meeting be taken from the table seconded by Grant, carried. The Motion to adopt the resolution being now before the Council, the vote upon its adoption resulted as follows. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes. W. A. Clark moved that the Clerk be instructed to prepare an Ordinance requiring that hereafter all Alley Crossings, Drive Ways and approaches to Basins be constructed of good hard brick sett edgways or good Stone upon a good foundation and of the same width as the Side Walk and cobble stone on each side of Crossing to hold brick or stone to its place; and that all Street Crossings hereafter ~~be~~ be constructed of good stone or good hard brick sett edgways on a good foundation of Stone gravel or Quicks, Stone Stringers 15 inches wide and at least 12 inches thick laid 12 inches apart and the space between and on either side to be filled with cobbles or street paving stone, well sett in, Motion seconded by Grant. Vote. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes. Mr Grant offered the following resolution and moved its adoption seconded by J. Miller, Resolved that a new side walk be and is hereby ordered on the north side of College Street from Portage Street west to College Campus, Vote. McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes. Clark moved that the Mayor and Street Committee be authorized to have the Civil Engineer run a grade on College Street from Arch Street west to end of said Street with the view of establishing

a grade on College Street, and report to council, seconded by Miller. Vote, McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark no, Johnson yes, Miller yes, Clark presented the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Grant, Resolved that a new side walk be and is hereby ordered in front of Lot No 71 H. E. Judd and Lot No 70 North side of West Main Street, Vote McLean yes, Grant yes, Clark yes, Johnson yes, Miller yes, Clark moved that there be no more money expended upon the streets than there is on hand from time to time seconded by Johnson all voted yes, Clark moved that the Mayor make application to the proper County Officer for all law books the incorporated village is entitled to, seconded by Miller carried, Clark moved that Grant and Miller be a committee to see what it would cost to have a door way cut through the wall from Mayor's office to prison and close up the out side door seconded by Johnson carried, Clark moved and Miller seconded the motion that council adjourn to meet at call of Mayor to act on ordinances and any other unfinished business, carried,
