Clark moved that Street Commissioners Bills  
 as read be accepted and orders issued on the  
 Treasurer from proper funds for their payment,  
 and the Street Committee instructed to notify  
 the Street Commissioner that hereafter no bills  
 of like character will be accepted, seconded by  
 McLean, Yeas, Johnson, Miller, Grant, McLean,  
 and Clark, Nays none, Councilman Clark  
 then called for the reading of the Ordinance  
 to establish a new Grade on Portage Street. The  
 Ordinance was then read by the Clerk, and on  
 Motion of Clark seconded by Miller the grade  
 ordinance was passed on its first reading by  
 vote as follows, yeas, Johnson, Miller, Grant,  
 McLean, and Clark, Nays none, Clark moved  
 that the rules be suspended so as to permit  
 the Grade Ordinance to be passed to its second,  
 and third ~~and~~ reading, and final passage,

 ed on its third reading, Seconded by Johnson,

 dinance be put upon its final passage, Seconded

 lishing the Grade on College Street, Seconded  
 by Miller, Vote yeas, Johnson, Miller, Grant, McLean,  
 Clark, Noes none, At this time Councilman Miller  
 withdrew from the Council Chamber, Clark moved  
 that the Mayor and Clerk be instructed to notify  
 all persons as their time expires for building new  
 side walks that unless they begin at once and  
 prosecute unto completion their walks, the Coun-  
 cil will proceed at once to have it done for them,  
 Seconded by Grant, Carried, Clark moved to adj-  
 -ourn seconded by Johnson, Carried.
