

Mount Union Ohio June 28<sup>th</sup> 1886

Called meeting of Council, Mayor Scott in the Chair  
 Roll Call. Members of Council present, Keller, McLean  
 Grant, Clark, Johnson and Miller. Minutes of  
 adjourned meeting June 22<sup>nd</sup> read and there being  
 no corrections the Mayor declared minutes ap-  
 proved, Reports being in order the Finance Com-  
 mittee reported that to the best they could learn  
 the bill of Cantline & Kay and of Oly & Love were  
 correct and recommended their payment. Clark  
 moved that the motion instructing the Clerk to no-  
 tify persons ordered to build new sidewalks as their  
 time expired for their construction that unless they  
 begin at once and complete their walks the Coun-  
 cil would proceed at once to have them put down  
 for them, seconded by Grant, Carried, Clark  
 moved that the question of instructing Clerk to  
 notify persons ordered to put down new sidewalks  
 as their time expired be laid on the table, second,  
 by Grant, Carried, Miller moved that all old  
 sidewalks which were considered dangerous and  
 had been ordered new, be torn up and the lum-  
 ber properly cared for, seconded by Clark vote  
 yeas Keller, McLean, Grant, Clark, Johnson, and  
 Miller, six yeas, Clark moved that the Mayor  
 and sidewalk committee be a committee  
 to take the legal steps to have the sidewalks  
 constructed, of those whose time has expired and  
 have failed to begin the work, and to see to hav-  
 ing the old walks torn up, seconded by Miller,  
 vote yeas, Grant, Clark, Johnson, Miller, Kay  
 Keller, McLean, four yeas two nays,  
 Clark moved that Mr Keller, the Mayor  
 Scott the Clerk and the Civil Engineer be a  
 committee to determine the grade of College  
 Street, seconded by Johnson, Carried, Clark moved  
 that the Cemetery Directors be instructed to procure  
 a book and make a record of names of all Sol-
