Miller, Reading of Minutes of previous meeting referred, The Mayor directed that the Clerk proceed to open and read the sealed Proposals received for the construction of Side walk of Miss Woods and Valley Street Crossing and Culverts, The first opened and read was one bid accompanied by a Bond as required presented by C. L. Hoiles for the construction of the Side walks of Miss E. C. Woods as follows, Mount Union Ohio July 6th 1886.
 To the Mayor and Council of Mt. Union Ohio,
 I will agree to construct the Side walks of Miss Eleanor C. Woods for the Council according to requirements for the sum of \$317.75.

 Ordinance to establish a grade on College Street
 was called for. The Ordinance was then read
 for the first time. Miller moved that the
 Ordinance be passed on its first reading.
