

Mount Union O, Aug. 3rd 1886.

Adjourned meeting of Council, Present Mayor Scott, Clerk J. W. Bard Councilman present W. H. Clark, J. H. McLean, J. Grant, and D. S. Johnson, absent S. Miller and H. Keller, Reading of Minutes of previous meeting deferred, Reading of Ordinance to borrow money for side walk purposes was called for, the Clerk then read the Ordinance, this being its third reading, It was moved by Clark and seconded by McLean that the ordinance be passed upon its third reading Vote Yeas Clark, McLean Grant and Johnson Nays None, Clark moved that the Ordinance be put upon its final passage seconded by Johnson Vote Yeas Clark, McLean, Grant, Johnson Nays none, Clark moved that the proposition of J. E. Moore to finish the foundation and pave with good paving brick the side walk of J. L. Dilworth on East side of North Portage Street for the sum of Eleven dollars per thousand brick; be accepted and that Mayor Scott and Councilman Grant be a Committee to see that the work is properly done, seconded by McLean, Vote Yeas Clark, McLean, Grant, Johnson, Nays none, Clark moved that the Street Committee be authorized to rent a suitable place to keep the tools &c belonging to the town in the City; seconded by McLean Vote Yeas Clark, McLean, Grant and Johnson, Nays none, Clark moved that the Mayor and Mr Grant be a Committee to see parties interested with reference to vacating the alley just west of Miss Carrie Hauser's lot; seconded by McLean, Carried unanimously, Moved by Clark seconded by Johnson Council adjourned.
