L. Cherry being called for, the following propositions were read, To the honorable Council of Mount Union Ohio, We the undersigned hereby agree to excavate, ballast and lay side walk on Portage Street according to plan and specifications for sum of Sixty Five cents per lineal foot all done

To the Council of the Village of Mount Union Ohio We will put the walk in front of the Cherry property on Portage Street using good brick as we have been using for \$193.75.

It was moved by Clark that the bid of Moore & Norman be accepted by the Council, seconded by Grant, at this time Councilman [unclear] entered and took his seat in Council, after discussion the vote resulted as follows, Grant, Johnson, Clark, Keller, Miller, none, Mayor declared bid of Moore & Norman accepted, Committee on Woods Walk reported that the walk was not finished according to specifications and were not ready to accept it. Clark moved that the Clerk and is hereby authorized to certify to the Auditor of Stark County to be placed on the tax duplicate for collection against Lot or land belonging to the heirs of Dr. [unclear] worth, the sum of Sixty Two Dollars and Five cents (\$62.85) together with the penalty of twenty per cent in addition. The bill has been presented to Mr. J. L. Delworth by Mayor and not paid, seconded by Grant, Johnson, Grant, Johnson, Clark, Keller, and says none.
