Regular meeting of Council, Mayor Scott present, Roll Call, Members of Council present D. S. Johnson H. Keller, S. Miller, J. H. McLean, J. Grant, and W. A. Clark, Minutes of last regular meeting read and approved, also Minutes of Called meetings of August 25th and 31st read and approved, Reception of reports. Mayor Scott reported that he had received from Township Trustees one dollar for use of Lockup.

Clerks report - Aug. 16th 1886 sent statement to Miss Eleanor C. Woods of cost of construction of her side walk \$327.42, and received an answer that she would pay for the same Oct. 1st 1886, Issued Bond No 7 to S. H. Hoiles Aug. 25th 1886 amount of \$500.00 at 7 per cent interest per annum to run two years the first years interest to draw the same rate of interest for the second year as the bond, Aug 30th 1886 Certified to County Auditor amount of the cost of construction of J. L. Dilworth's side walk \$62.85 together with penalty of 20 per cent total \$75.42, and \$115 against Lot No 58 belonging to heirs of John W. Johnson for cleaning privy, Miller moved that Clerks report be received, seconded by Keller, Carried, Mr Keller of the side walk committee stated that he had noticed the side walk of Margaret Pow during its construction and had looked it over since it was finished and thought it well done, after considerable discussion of the finance question Mr Clark moved that the Clerk be authorized to change the distribution of the March installment of funds from the County Treasurer, in accordance with the Levy as there had been a wrong distribution by the former Clerk, seconded by Grant, Vote Yeas, Johnson, Keller, Nay Miller, yeas
