Monday Ev, May 20, 1878.

Council convened in regular session Mayor Day presiding Roll called. Present Beardsley Probst Transue Coates Ellison Gray.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Petition of citizens on Webb St. asking for three or four lamp posts to be put up on said street was read and on motion referred to Gas Committee.

On Motion passed to 1st reading and Ordinance fixing the rate of taxation and distribution of the same for the year A D 1878. Motion of Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass second and third reading and final passage seconded by Coates and carried by the following vote. Yeas - Beardsley Transue Probst Coates Ellison Gray. - Yeas - 5 Nays - 0.

The Ordinance then passed second and third reading reading and vote on its final stage as before, yeas - 5 Nays - 0. The Mayor then declared the Ordinance duly passed.

On Motion passed to 1st reading an Ordinance to regulate the use of animals and teams. In accordance with the Municipal Code page 205, Sec 584. Mayor Day presented the names of E. H. Brosius Richard Lee B. F. Mincer to make etc

That a new walk be ordered down on the West side of Nixon Shop.

That the walks on North and South side of Patterson St be repaired to Corporation limits.

That the walks on North Walnut St be repaired to Corporation limits.
