

Council Chamber, Mt Union Ohio April 26th 1887
 Roll called - Members present Mayor Geo. Scott, Councilmen
 Henry B. Schooley, Sylvanus Miller, Jos
 Grant & W. A. Clark. The minutes of meetings of April
 12th and 19th were read and approved.

Reading of reports called for. Mr Miller offered a report
 on Sidewalks as follows. That there are two walks needed
 in front of the property of Henry W Martin, north side of street.
 John H Stamp to set new walk. Joseph P Weir, property
 Southside, Dr John P. Grewells, David Horners, Colet
 Johnson, Mrs. Delilah Wickard on main street.

Mrs Eliza Jennings to ft. Rev Charles Huffin on College Street
 Rev Leggett, Joshua B. Scott & Henry Keller on College St.
 Sylvanus Miller on main street.

Mr Clark offered the following resolution. viz that the walks
 above mentioned by the committee be ordered built

At this time Councilman Kingsbury took his seat in the
 Council. Henry Schooley moved the resolution be
 adopted - seconded by Mr Kingsbury. Vote ayes. Schooley
 Kingsbury, Miller, Grant & Clark. so ordered.

Mr Miller reported Private Crossings needed as follows
 at the property of Parker Morris, Wm Hoiles, and George
 Myers on Main Street. Clark offered a Resolution that
 the Private Crossings as named be ordered built according
 to the ordinance. Miller moved the Resolution be adopted
 Sec by Jos Grant, Vote ayes Schooley, Kingsbury, Miller
 Grant and Clark.

Miller reported new Crossings
 across the street from E. St. Hartshorns to John Boyers, across
 Postage street. Crossings at alleys at, Henry Martins & Sylvanus
 Miller, at Dr Rices, & E. T. Conns. Clark moved
 the street and Alley crossings above described be ordered
 built and the clerk directed to notify all the above
 named persons to build the walks. seconded by
 Miller. Vote ayes Schooley, Kingsbury, Miller
 Grant & Clark. Clark moved that the parties be

ordered to have foundations for walks completed within
 thirty days, and the walk all finished within 60 days.
 Vote ayes Schooley, Kingsbury, Miller, Grant, & Clark.

Clark moved to adjourn to meet at the call of the Mayor
 Sec by Miller an carried. W. P. Rice clerk.
