

Meeting of Council held on June 24th 1887  
 as per adjournment from June 16th. Roll called  
 Members present Messrs Miller. Clark. Schooley  
 Kingsbury and Grant. The Mayor being absent  
 Clark moved, That C. S. Kingsbury be as  
 Chairman pro-tem, seconded by Miller and  
 carried. Mr Clark ~~moved~~ called for the  
 reading of the Ordinance relating to Riding of  
 Bicycles - Tricycles and Velocipedes upon the Sidewalks  
 of the Village. The Ordinance was read by The  
 Clerk. Mr Clark moved the Ordinance pass  
 upon its first reading. seconded by Miller  
 and carried vote as follows Ayes Clark - Schooley  
 Miller. Kingsbury and Grant. Mr Clark  
 asked for the reading of the Ordinance ~~prohibiting~~  
 prohibiting Ball playing upon the Streets alleys  
 and sidewalks of the Village. ~~which was at this~~  
 time Mayor Scott came in & took his seat in the  
 Council. The Clerk read the Ball ordinance.  
 Clark moved the Ordinance pass upon its  
 first reading. seconded by Kingsbury. vote  
 on passage Ayes Miller - Schooley Grant  
 Kingsbury & Clark. Mr Clark moved the  
 rules be so suspended as that the Ordinances  
 just read be placed upon their second & third  
 reading and final passage. seconded by  
 Mr Miller & carried - vote ayes. Clark  
 Miller - Schooley. Kingsbury & Clark.  
~~Miller moved the Bicycle Ordinance~~  
 The Clerk now read the Bicycle ordinance  
 & Mr Miller moved the Ordinance be  
 passed upon its second reading. seconded  
 by Clark. vote on motion Ayes Schooley  
 Kingsbury. Grant. Miller & Clark.  
 The Ordinance was again read for the third time  
 and Mr Clark moved the Ordinance pass upon  
 its third reading and final passage - seconded by  
 Miller - vote ayes. Schooley Kingsbury Grant  
 Clark and Miller. The Mayor declared the Ordinance  
 passed -

The Ball Ordinance was called up and read the second time  
 Mr Kingsbury moved the Ball Ordinance pass upon  
 its 2nd reading - seconded by Grant, and carried vote  
 ayes, Schoolay, Miller Clark, Grant and Kingsbury  
 The Ordinance was again placed upon its third  
 reading, and Kingsbury moved the Ordinance pass  
 upon its 3rd reading - seconded by Miller, vote  
 ayes, Schoolay, Clark, Grant, Miller & Kingsbury  
 The Mayor declared the Ordinance duly passed,  
 and the Clerk was directed to publish both Ordinances  
 by written orders - The report of the engineer called for  
 and given to the Council by E. H. Stanley, and the Committee  
 on grades continued to report at a future meeting in  
 regard to the alteration of the grade on Main Street.

Clark moved the Crossing  
 Committee be authorized to build a new crossing  
 at the Church, also at the alleys where new  
 crossings are needed & when the committee think  
 they should be built. And that the Clerk be instructed  
 to advertise for proposals for the construction  
 of the same, to be constructed in accordance with  
 the ordinance providing for construction of crossings,  
 & that all bids be subject to rejection by the Council,  
 at their option. Motion Sec'd by Miller, vote  
 in motion Ayes Schooley, Kingsbury Grant  
 Clark, and Miller

Clark moved the Side-  
 walk Committee ascertain how many and  
 which sidewalks need to be made new & report  
 to next meeting. Sec'd by Kingsbury, vote  
 Ayes Schooley, Grant, Miller, Kingsbury, Clark  
 Clark asked for information about the Marshal  
 waiting for his salary and the Committee  
 reported the Marshal was willing to wait for his  
 pay until the Council were prepared to pay him.  
 Kingsbury moved to adjourn to the call of  
 the Mayor. Sec'd by Schooley & carried
