

Council Chamber, July 26th 1887.

Council convened at the call of the Mayor. Members present Mayor Scott, Councilmen, C. J. Kingsbury, W. A. Clark, S. Miller, H. Schooley, and Joe Grant. In the absence of the clerk, W. A. Clark was appointed clerk pro tem. Side walk committee reported the walk on College street adjoining property of Leeper Steel & Rail Road Co. completed. C. J. Kingsbury moved the walk be accepted. Motion seconded by H. Schooley, vote on motion ayes, Kingsbury, Grant, Miller, Schooley & Clark. The bill of the Clerk, as itemized statement, for fifteen dollars and fifty nine cents (\$15.59) for Quarter ending June 30th was approved by finance committee, and Miller moved an order be issued on the proper fund for the payment thereof. Seconded by Kingsbury and carried ayes, Schooley, Clark, Miller, Grant & Kingsbury. On motion the Mayor was appointed a committee to see that the College, through E. A. Hartstorn, fulfill their agreement, by building a walk from College to College street. On motion adjourned.
