Monday Evening May 27. 1878.

Council convened in special session Mayor Day presiding. Roll called present - Brardley Probst - Truman Coates Ellison Gray.

Petition of Citizens for a lamp post on corner of Arch and College Streets - Motion of Gray and seconded by Brardley that the matter be referred to Gas Committee.

The following was read.

Richard Lee Enos H. Brosius and Benjamin D. Mercer, Disinterested freeholders of the Incorporated Village of Alliance said county being sworn say That they will truly, honestly and impartially estimate and report to the Council of said Incorporated Village of Alliance an estimated assessment of the cost and expense of grading, paving curbing and otherwise improving Alliance St. between the Clearland and Pittsburgh Rail Road and Arch Street on the lots abounding or abutting on said Street between said points in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to each of said lots or parcels of land and perform the other duties required of them by law in the premises according to the best of their knowledge and ability.




Report of Estimate of Assessment, To the Town
Council of the Incorporated Village of
Alliance Stark Co Ohio.

Assess
We the Undersigned freeholder of the In-
corporated Village of Alliance Stark County
Ohio having been appointed by your hon-
orable body to estimate the assessment of the
costs of grading curbing paving and other-
wise improving Alliance Street between the
Clearland and Pittsburg Rail Road and Arch
Street according to certain plans and speci-
fications, on file in the Office of the Village
Clerk. On the lots and parcels of land
abounding and abutting on said street be-
tween the points aforesaid, do in pursuance
of the provisions of section Five Hundred
and eighty four of an act of the General
Assembly of the State of Ohio. Entitled an
act to provide for the organization and
government of Municipal Corporations, passed
May 9th 1869 respectfully report to your Hon-
orable Body that the assessment on the lots and parcels
of lands, abounding and abutting upon
said Alliance Street between the Clearland
and Pittsburgh Rail Road and Arch street-
as estimated by us. Is Five Dollars and
seventy three cents (5.73⁰⁰) upon each foot-
of frontage of each lot or parcel of land
abutting thereon. In Testimony whereof we
hereto set our hands and seal this 24th
day of May AD 1878.

Moved by Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass 2nd and 3rd reading and final passage seconded by Ellison and carried by the following vote. yeas. Beardley Probst - Transue Levates Ellison Gray. yeas - 6 Nays - 0. The Ordinance then passed 2nd and 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas - 6 Nays - 0. The Mayor then declared the Ordinance duly passed.

A Remonstrance was read signed by property owners against improving Alliance Street between the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Rail Road and Arch Street. On motion of Levates seconded by Ellison the Remonstrance was referred to Street Committee.

Motion of Levates seconded by Probst that a new walk be laid down on the North Side of Walnut Street from Mechanic Street to Park Street.

Motion of Levates seconded by Probst that a new Russell walk with railing on both side across the run be laid on the West side of Park Street and south of Union School House in front of J. Lewis property.

On motion of Beardley seconded by Levates Council adjourned to meet at next regular meeting.
