

Council Chamber, Mt Union O., Sept 13th 1887
 Roll called. Mayor Scott, presiding. Present
 Councilmen, S. Miller, H. B. Schooley, J. Grant
 and C. T. Kingsbury. Keller and Clark absent
 Minutes of last meeting read and there being no
 corrections, they stood approved.

C. L. Hoile presented a bid, by sealed proposal, for the
 construction of Joseph P. Heirs, Sidewalk
 Miller moved the bill be laid on the table
 Seconded by Kingsbury and carried all
 voting yes. A petition was presented
 and read, asking that there be no action taken
 that will lead to the annexation of the village of
 Mt Union to the Village of Alliance, signed by 86
 persons. Miller moved to lay the Petition on
 the table, Seconded by Mr Schooley, and Carried.
 The following order was read.

Mt Union O. July 22nd 87

To the Council of the incorporated Village of Mt Union O.
 Please pay to Mr Samuel Garretson the sum of
 twenty five dollars (\$25.00), salary due me as Town
 Marshal from April 87 to July 87.

Kingsbury moved that the bill and order be accepted
 and the Clerk instructed to issue an order for its
 payment, whenever there is money in the treasury
 to the credit of the Police fund, as paid from County
 treasury from the levy already made. Seconded
 by Miller and carried vote ayes Grant
 Schooley, Miller and Kingsbury.
 Grant moved the Clerk be instructed to
 issue an order to Uriah Thomas for the Five Hundred
 dollars and interest on bond due Sept 2nd 87.
