Councilman Clark offered the following Resolution: viz Resolved that the request of the petitioners be granted, and that we proceed immediately to pass said Ordinance, resolution seconded by Miller. Vote on resolution Ayes Clark - Keller Miller Kingsbury and Schooley. nays. Grant. Motion carried. The clerk read the following Ordinance viz

An Ordinance to Submit to vote of electors the question of annexation of the Village of Mt Union to the City of Alliance Ohio.

Clark moved the Ordinance pass upon its first reading, seconded by Mr Kingsbury. Vote Ayes - Clark, Keller - Schooley, Miller, and Kingsbury. Grant did not vote. Clark moved the rules be so suspended as to place the ordinance upon its second and third reading and final passage. Seconded by Keller. Vote Ayes Clark, Keller, Schooley, Miller, Kingsbury - Grant not voting - Clerk read the Ordinance the second time Mr Miller moved it pass upon its 2nd reading, seconded by Keller. Vote ayes Clark, Keller, Schooley, Kingsbury and Miller - Grant not voting.

Ordinance now read the third time. Clark moved the Ordinance pass upon its third and final reading - seconded by Kingsbury, and carried. Vote Ayes Clark, Grant, Keller, Miller Kingsbury, and Schooley. The Mayor declared it duly passed. Clark moved the Mayor & Clerk be authorized to notify the Alliance City Council of the action of this Council in regard to annexation and request them to take similar action on the part of Alliance. Sec by Keller. Vote Clark, Grant, Keller, Kingsbury Miller & Schooley. Clark moved the Sidewalk Committee examine all the walks, ordered built and see if they are built according to requirements of Council and report to the Council, so the Clerk can give certificates to the parties that the walks are built according to requirements - Sec by Kingsbury - and carried. Miller moved that all walks and crossings be put to the present established grade. seconded by Clark. Vote, Schooley no. Clark yes. Grant yes Keller yes. Kingsbury yes. Miller yes. carried
