Regular Meeting of Council, Oct 11th 1887
Present Mayor Scott - Councilmen, Clark Kingsbury, Schooley & Miller.
Minutes of last meeting read and approved.
Sidewalk Committee report They have not examined any of the newly constructed walks, and are not ready to report on their construction, as to requirement of ordinance, but report that the sidewalks of Caleb Johnson, and J. P. Weir are not yet built. At this time Councilman Henry Kellar came in & took his seat in the council. Clark moved the Mayor and Clerk issue a Bond to John T. Abraham in the sum of Forty eight dollars and fifty cents (\$48.50), at 6% annual interest, running one year, for money to place in Sidewalk fund, Seconded by S. Miller. Vote ayes, Schooley, Kellar, Kingsbury, Clark and Miller.
Le L. Hoiles presented a bill of \$48.50 for constructing Sidewalk in front of Delilah Richards Lot No 9, on West Main Street.
48.50 Clark moved the Delilah Richards Walk be accepted

subject to the approval of the Sidewalk Committee, and an order issued in favor of C. L. Hoiles for Forty Eight dollars and fifty cents. (48.50) for constructing the same, payable from the proper fund, and the Clerk instructed to present the bill for same to owner or agent, and if not paid to send as a levy to County Auditor. Seconded by Mr Keller vote ayes Clark-Miller-Kingsbury-Kellar and Schooley.

Clark moved the Street crossing committee be authorized to contract with some person to clean Street crossings. Sec by Kingsbury vote ayes. Clark. Kingsbury Kellar, Miller and Schooley.

Clark moved the Mayor appoint the requisite number of councilmen to conduct the election on Nov. 8th. Sec by Kellar - vote ayes Kingsbury - Miller - Kellar Clark and Schooley.

Miller moved that Mr Clark as member of finance committee be authorized to examine the Auditor & Treasurers books at Canton and see if all our special levies have been placed on the tax duplicate, and whether any have been paid, &c &c. and present bill of expense to Council. Sec by Kingsbury
