

Council Chamber

W Union J. May 18 - 1888

Council met in an adjourned session
Meeting was called to order by Mayor.

Roll called. Members present:
Kingsbury, Clark, Miller, Scott and
Schowley.

Scott of the street crossing committee
reported that new crossings were need-
ed at the following places. Viz:

one from Millers to Emsts across Main St.

one " " " " Barnhous " Portage "

one " Barnhous to Mrs Mapels across Main St

one " Judds to Davidsons

one " E. N. Harlshous to College St.

one Arch Street crossing.

Also the following Alley crossings
one Between Bard house and Mrs Swets house

one " Mrs Harlshous and Robins "

one at Henry Martins Shop.

Clark moved that the clerk be in-
structed to prepare an ordinance to
change section (II) two of the ordinance
providing for the construction of street
and alley crossings, so as to allow crossing to
be built on an excavation less than
twelve (12) inches, and top to be one (1)
solid stone covering center instead of
two (2) stringers, the one stone to be
as wide as the former two (2) stringers
and the width between them.

Motion seconded by Kingsbury, vote aye.
Clark, Schowley, Scott, Miller & Kingsbury
(carried)

Clark moved that the street and alley
crossings reported by Scott be mentioned
in the contract to build street and alley
crossings and to put streets to grade
and if there be sufficient money in

The Treasury to have the privilege of adding more crossings at a similar rate. Motion seconded by Miller vote aye. Miller, Clark, Scott, Schooley and Kingsbury, (Carried)

Clark moved that Miller be authorized to employ J. Conrad to repair the cherry sidewalk. seconded by Kingsbury all voting aye the motion carried.

Clark moved that the Mayor be instructed to notify Charley Hunter of the liability of any damages of the conduct of his Renters.

Seconded by Scott. Motion carried unanimously

The Clerk presented his bill of Ten and $\frac{93}{100}$ (#10⁹³) dollars for writing 10930 words @ 10¢ per hundred.

By motion of Clark seconded by Miller the Bill was ordered paid from the Contingent fund.

Clark moved the Clerk advertise to receive sealed proposals for 7 days (10) instead of twenty (20) as previously ordered. Seconded by Scott. all voting aye the motion carried.

On motion of Clark the meeting adjourned to the call of the Chairman
