Wt Union Co. June 5<sup>th</sup> 1888.

Council met in the Mayors office <sup>as per adjournment.</sup> meeting called to order by Chairman Rice Roll called. members present; Stanley, Miller, Scott, Schooley and Kingsbury.

The following sealed proposal was then opened and read.

Wt Union Co. June 5<sup>th</sup> 1888.

To the Council of Wt Union Corporation C.  
Gullemin:

I propose to take the contract of Grading Main street - Wt Union from the A. T. & T. Railroad crossing to the east side of the public school grounds, and grading Portage street from the north side of the Public Square to the north side of Leubaughs orchard - and put both of said streets to the established grade, as the same is established by Ordinance and as per grade status set by engineer Giger. including gutters and side ditches and do the work in a good and proper manner, The dirt that is not needed to make the necessary fills on the said streets to be put on the streets as follows. viz on Main street east of the school lot, between the end of aforesaid grade & Arch street where needed

to bring street to grade, and on south Portage St. south of the part put to grade, the dirt to be put at nearest convenient point on either street where street is not already up to required grade. And south of the square on Portage street the gutters shall be raised sufficient to carry the water across the square north. The entire street or streets shall be nine inches lower on each side than in the centre. Said work to be subject to inspection and approval of engineer Grizer. And work completed within 60 days from date of contract. I hereby agree to perform the above labor according to all the above plans and specifications, given, for the sum of Two hundred and fifty ( $250.00$ ) dollars.

A. proposal by E. L. Hoiles, same as above, except the sum, which was Two hundred and twenty five ( $225.00$ ) dollars, was also read. Stanley moved that since Moore has specified the work to be done, his bid be accepted. Seconded by Scott, Vote: Scott yes, Stanley yes, Schooler yes, Miller yes, Kingsbury yes. (So ordered)

Scott moved that the Clerk be instructed to inform Mr Moore of the action of the Council, and Mayor and Clerk enter into contract with him. Seconded by Kingsbury, all voted aye. Carried.

On motion of Scott the Clerk was instructed to notify J. P. Wier that if he does not proceed to finish his sidewalk with stone or brick on or before the 12<sup>th</sup> of June, 1888, the Council will proceed to contract for same.

on motion meeting adjourned to regular meeting June 12<sup>th</sup> 1888.
