

Mt Union Co. June 14th 1888.

Council met in town hall at 8 o'clock
Meeting called to order by Mayor Rice.

Roll called: Members present
Stanley, Scott, Miller, Schooley, & Kingsbury
Minutes of previous meetings were read and
approved.

The question of accepting the report of
the commissioners, on annexation was
then taken up. Stanley moved that
Council defer action on said report
until some future time. Seconded by
Miller. Vote Stanley yes, Miller yes.
Scott yes, Schooley yes, Kingsbury yes.
Carried.

Reception of reports was next in order.
On motion of Scott Clerk was instructed to
give E. C. Bard a certificate of the sidewalk
built in front of his property being constructed
according to ordinance.

Reading Bills and accepting same
The following bills were then read.

- \$ 2.58 To D Conrad for cleaning crossings and 6 #
nails \$ 2.58
- \$ 2.60 To D. Conrad for lighting lamps \$ 2.60
- \$ 1.50 To do for repairing st crossings \$ 1.50
- \$ 10.25 To J. C. Reed for clerking as per itemized bill \$ 10.25

Scott moved the bills be accepted and
orders drawn on their proper funds for the
payment of same. Seconded by Miller
Vote Stanley yes, Scott yes, Miller yes, Schooley
yes, Kingsbury yes. Carried.

Scott moved that the Clerk prepare an
ordinance to borrow money to provide the
means for drilling a public well.

seconded by Kingsbury, vote aye. Miller, Stanley, Scott, Schooley and Kingsbury.

Clerk then an Ordinance to provide the means for paying the cost and expenses of drilling a well in the south west corner of Public square. in Mt Union A.

Scott moved that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. seconded by Kingsbury vote Stanley yes, Miller yes, Scott yes, Schooley yes, and Kingsbury yes.

Kingsbury moved that the rules be suspended so as to allow the ordinance to be passed on its second and third reading and final passage. seconded by Schooley, vote Stanley yes, Scott yes, Schooley yes, Miller yes, Kingsbury yes, Carried. Clerk read ordinance second time.

Stanley moved the ordinance pass ~~on~~ its second reading, seconded by Kingsbury, vote aye. Miller, Scott, Stanley, Schooley and Kingsbury, Carried. The Ordinance ^{was} then read the third time.

Scott moved that the ordinance pass on its third reading and final passage. seconded by Miller, vote Stanley yes, Scott yes, Miller yes, Schooley yes, and Kingsbury yes.

Mayor declared ordinance passed.

Stanley moved that the sidewalk committee be authorized to contract the building of the sidewalk in front of the Blackburn property. motion seconded by Miller, all voting aye the motion carried.

An motion Stanley and Scott were authorized to contract for drilling a well, according to ordinance, in the village of Mount-Union A. as soon as provision is made for the money to pay for the same.
