Alliance O July 27 1878

Council convened in regular session Mayor Day presiding Roll called present Probst - Fransue, Coates, Ellison Gray. Absent - Beardsley. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Motion of Ellison seconded by Probst that the Street Committee be instructed to act in regard to purchasing a horse for the town team.

Petition of citizens asking for a lamp post on the corner of North Liberty and Patterson Street - On motion referred to Gas Committee.

On motion of Gray seconded by Coates that a lamp post be erected at the corner of the Alley by the M. E. Church. The following was read.

To the Hon Mayor & Council

The undersigned committee to whom was referred the matter of locating gas posts respectfully recommend that eight additional posts be erected as follows.

at N. W. Cor of College and Linden Ave Streets

One post to be located by committee.
