

Council Chamber Mt Union O. July 9th 1888.

Council met as per adjournment.

In the absence of Mayor Rice Councilman Scott was elected chairman for the evening.

Roll called. Members present, Scott, Lelark, Miller, Schooley & Kingsbury.

The chairman stated that the object of the meeting was to consider bids for paving the public square and putting sewer through same.

The following bid was then read.

Antrains
bid for
paving square.

To pave the Public Square in Mt Union O. 52 feet square. One foot of earth to be excavated, 8 inches of gravel, paved with machine fire brick, also a sewer on east side of square, from walk to walk, to be made from stone taken from the old crossing as far as it goes. Sewer to be 18 inches wide & the top stone to be Austin stone 4 inches thick and 2 feet wide drainage from the south to be turned west at Garretsons corner.

To cost

\$355.78

Hand made brick twenty four ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars each 24.00

Same as above, except that 15 inches of excavation be made, and 5 or 6 inch stone (field stone) be used for paving. said stone to be covered with gravel. this to cost

\$240⁰⁰

A bid was also read, proposing to do above named work, less the sewer, for \$372. made by C. L. Hoiles.

Lelark moved that Antrains bid for putting in the sewer and paving the square with field stone be accepted. seconded by Kingsbury vote:

Miller no, Schooley no, Lelark yes, Kingsbury yes. Scott no. motion lost.

Miller moved that we have the square paved with machine made fire brick, seconded by Schooley vote: Kingsbury no, Lelark no, Miller yes, Schooley yes, Scott yes. Carried.

Clark moved that - antram's bid of \$333.78
 for paving the square and putting in sewer as
 per bid be accepted; Seconded by Miller:
 vote - aye: Clark, Miller, Scott, Schooley. no
 Kingsbury. On motion adjourned to
