

Council Chamber, Mt Union O. July 11th 1888

Council met in Council Chamber.

In the absence of the clerk, W. A. Clark was elected Clerk Pro Tem. Roll called Members present Scott, Stanley, Clark, Schooley and Miller.

E. Redder presented a bill of three dollars for hauling six loads of dirt for filling crossing

On motion of Stanley seconded by Miller the bill was accepted and Clerk instructed to issue an order for the amt of three dollars providing the bill included Hoile's charge.

The Reading of Ordinances was called for.

The Clerk then read an Ordinance providing the means for paying the cost and expense of paving the public Square.

Scott moved that the Ordinance pass on its first reading, seconded by Miller, vote aye & Stanley, Schooley, Scott, Miller, and Clark.

Miller moved that the rules be suspended so as to put the ordinance to its second & third reading and final passage. Seconded by Stanley vote Clark yes, Scott yes, Miller yes, Stanley yes & Schooley yes. Carried, Stanley moved that the ordinance pass on its second reading.

seconded by Scott vote aye. Stanley, Clark, Scott, Miller & Schooley. Carried. Ordinance read third time. Scott moved that the ordinance pass upon its third reading and final passage. seconded by Miller vote, Scott yes, Stanley yes, Miller yes, Schooley yes, & Clark yes. Carried and declared passed by the Mayor.

Miller moved that J. F. Antrains bid for paving the square with machine made fire brick be accepted and the Clerk authorized to enter into contract with him so soon as the ordinance becomes a law. and the money is in the Treasury. seconded by Stanley vote Miller yes, Stanley yes, Scott yes, Schooley yes.
