

Council Chamber, Mt Union O. July 27/58

Council met at the call of the Mayor.

Roll called: members present, Clark, Miller, Scott, Kingsbury. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Reception of Reports next in order.

At this time Stanley came in and took his seat in the Council.

Clark reported that he notified Garrison to fill his well & put his hitching out to the proper place, also notified Mrs Hassler to fill well under her walk and C. Johnson to remove the tree from off his sidewalk. Also the owners of lots Nos 1. 2. 11. 12 23 and 10, <sup>on main st</sup> to put their walks to grade.

Clark moved that the report be accepted and the notices be put on file. Seconded by Miller, and Carried unanimously.

Clark then read the following Bills.

Scott moved and Stanley seconded that the bills be accepted and orders drawn on their proper funds for the payment of same. Carried.

Clark then read report from Alliance City Clerk, wherein he certified that the Commissioners Report was accepted by the Alliance Council by ordinance. An motion of Clark seconded by Stanley Clark was instructed to make a note in the minutes of this report and the report put on file.

Clark moved that the Contractors be requested to put in an extra bid for laying under the paving. <sup>of square paving</sup> seconded by Miller, carried

Arthur the Contractor informed the Council that the tiling would cost \$6.50 extra.

Clark moved that the additional \$6.50 bid be accepted, seconded by Stanley, all voting aye the motion carried.

A contract was then read, and on motion of Clark seconded Stanley, the contract was accepted and the clerk ordered to make a minute of same and contract put on file.

A contract was then read for paving the public square and putting down a sewer through the square. An motion of Clark seconded by Stanley the contract was accepted and ordered placed on file by the clerk.

Clerk then read the following Bills

To J. C. Reed services as clerk eighteen  $\frac{99}{100}$  dollars. On motion of Clark seconded by Stanley the Bills were accepted and ordered paid.

Clark moved and Stanley seconded that the Bal due J. B. Scott for services as Police \$38.57 be paid as soon as the money is in the Police fund. Motion carried unanimously. Clark moved that in view of his faithful services, we recommend, Henry Grimes to the Alliance Council as a suitable person for Police of our ward. Seconded by Stanley Carried.

Clark moved that we request the Alliance Council to continue the well committee of Mr Union until the well is finished, seconded by Stanley, Carried

Mayor Rice then nominated W. A. Clark, and Dr A. N. Hartston, to represent Mt. Union Ward in the Alliance Council. An motion both nominations were confirmed by the Council.

On motion of Clark, seconded by Scott,  
the Clerk was instructed to forward all  
certificates necessary to the completion  
of the annexation to the Alliance Clerk.
