+ One motion passed to 1st reading an ordinance to Levy and assess a special tax on Alliance Street between the Cleveland and Pittsburg Rail road and Arch Street

Moved by Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2nd and 3rd reading and final passage. seconded by Coates and carried by the following vote - Yeas: Beardsley, Trausne, Coates, Gray. Yeas 4 - Nays 0. The ordinance then passed 2nd and 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood as before. Yeas 4, Nays 0. The Mayor then declared the ordinance duly passed

Motion of Gray seconded by Beardsley that an order be drawn for \$650. in favor of O. H. Gray, to apply on the Shiller judgment

Motion of Gray seconded by Trausne that the Mayor be instructed to procure blank certificates for civil engineers on grade of sidewalks

There being no further business council adjourned.
