Alliance @ Oct. 21, 1898

Council convened in regular session Mayor Day presiding. Roll called present
Beardsley Probst Evans Coates Gray

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

The committee to whom was referred the repairing of bridge on Park Street reported that the business belonged to County Commissioners and would be attended to. The Committee to whom

was referred the case of J Oglins stone wall asked for further time which was granted

Motion of Coates seconded by Probst that the stream of water running on the West side of Baily's property on the East side of Mechanic Street and through Kochs property be referred to Street Committee

On motion of Beardsley seconded by Gray passed to 1st reading the following Resolution viz.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance (two thirds of all the members concurring) that the proposal of M M Kirby to furnish the curbers for the improving of Alliance Street between the Cleaveland and Pittsburgh Rail Road and Arch Street for the sum of ten cents per load be accepted and the Mayor and clerk be authorized to enter into a contract with the said M M Kirby for the furnishing of the same

Motion to permit the Resolutions to pass 2nd and 3rd reading was lost by the following vote yeas Beardsley Dransue Gray, Nays Coates Probst yeas 3 Nays 2

The Mayor declared the motions lost (At this juncture H C Ellison came in and took his seat)

Communication from Alliance gas Co was read and on motion of Gray seconded by Probst referred to gas Committee

Motion of Ellison seconded by Dransue that the matter of striking off the South East half of Jenkins farm be taken out of the hands of the Council Motion carried
