Council convened in regular session

Mayor Day presiding, Roll called present. Beardsley, Probst, Fransue, Coates, Ellison, Gray. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

The Committee to whom was referred the case of J Ogline against the Village of Alliance for damages done his property by the stone wall being washed away are of the opinion that the Village is not liable for any damages. Moved by Probst that the report be accepted, seconded by Coates and carried.

Monthly statement of J A Miller sidewalk Commissioner, for lumber and spikes was read and on motion of Gray seconded by Fransue accepted and ordered filed.

Monthly report of Mayor Day for fines and licences amounting to \$25.00 was read and on motion accepted and ordered filed

Petition of citizens asking for two gasoline lamps and fountains on East Broadway was read

On motion of Gray seconded by Probst referred to gas committee

Petition of citizens to establish a grade along the alley running between Steybricht and Greener, from Linden-ave to Arch street was read and on motion of Coates seconded by Transue referred to grade committee

The committee to whom was referred the petition for a side walk on South Liberty Street reported unfavorable moved by Coates that the petition be laid on the table seconded by Beardley and carried

The Street Committee to whom was referred the investigation of the stream of water running through the alley at the corner of Led Coppor property reported the necessity of a stone wall Motion of Gray seconded by Beardley that the committee be instructed to build said wall

Moved by Gray and seconded by Probst that the Solicitor be instructed to prepare and ordonnance prohibiting the placing of extended signs over the side walk or street motion carried
