Council convened in regular session Mayor Day presiding Roll called Present Beardsley Stransue Coates Ellison Gray Absent Probst Minutes of last meeting read and approved

Statement of J A Weller for Lumber and spikes was read and on motion of Coates seconded by Stransue accepted and ordered filed.

The Mayor's report fines and licenses for the month of November amounting to \$850 was

read and on motion accepted and ordered filed

Motion of Gray seconded by Trausne that Dr. Russell's bill for attending Mr Bondure child be refered back to Council, motion carried

Motion of Ellison seconded by Trausne that Thirty Five Dollars, (\$35) be tendered Dr Russell for his services in attending Mr Bondure Child motion carried.

The following Resolution was read - viz  
 + Be it Resolved by the Council of the the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio (two thirds of all the members concurring) that the Austin Shagstone & the contractors for the improvement of Alliance Street are hereby requested to delay any further work on said Street until the opening of Spring 1879 on account of the unfavorable weather and that said contractors shall resume the said improvement at as early a day in the coming Spring as practicable and to prosecute the same to completion without delay. Motion of Gray that the Resolution be adopted seconded by Beardsley and carried.

A Ordinance to regulate Pawubkers. was read Moved by Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the Ordinance to pass 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and final passage, seconded by Ellison and Carried by the following vote -
