Motion of Ellison seconded by Coates that the Clerk be authorized to draw an order on the Treasury to the amt of \$1800.49 in favor of Finance Committee to finish paying off the Shidler judgment. motion carried

* The following Resolutions passed to 1st Reading. Resolved, That in the opinion of this Council (two thirds of all the members concurring) it is deemed necessary to grade, drain, curb, pave, and otherwise improve that part of Freedom Street lying between the Pittsburg Port-Wayne and Chicago Rail way and Market Street including the public square thereon. To conform to the established grade of said street and square. In accordance with the Plans and Profile on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Resolved that in the opinion of this Council (two thirds of all the members concurring) It is deemed necessary to grade, drain, curb, pave, and otherwise improve that part of Alliance Street lying between Arch Street and West side of Mt Union Avenue to conform to the established grade of said Street.
