Council convened in regular session, Mayor

was read and on motion of Transue sec-
onded by Ellison accepted and ordered filed.
Report of W. C. Soule Clerk was read and
motion of Beardsley seconded by Transue
accepted and ordered filed.

communication of Mr. Marchant
asked for further time which was
granted.
