Alliance O Feb. 3rd. / 879

Council convened in regular session.

Mayor Day presiding Roll called. present
Beardsley Transue Probst Coates Ellison
Gray. Minutes of last meeting read
and approved.

Mayor Day's report of fines and licenses
amounting to \$50.50, was read. On motion
of Ellison seconded by Gray accepted and
filed.

Monthly statement of J. A. Walter
of Lumber and spikes was read on
motion of Probst seconded by Beardsley
accepted and ordered filed.

Statement of J. M. Webb, Chief Engineer
of Alliance Fire Department for year
ending Jan 1st / 879 was read, on motion
of Ellison seconded by Coates received,
and referred to Fire Committee to report
on the several suggestions at next meeting.

Motion of Gray seconded by Beardsley
that the matter in regard to Mr Greenly's
building on Fifth Street near Merchants
Opera House be referred to City Solicitor
to Report at next meeting. motion carried.

Moved by Gray seconded by Ellison.
that the Building Committee be au-
thorized to cancel the old policy and
have the Insurance renewed, and change
\$1500.00 on the Building, \$250.00 on the Bell
\$150.00 on Safe, \$200.00 on Furniture. Total
\$2100.00 motion carried.

The Committee to whom was referred the
Petition asking for a Tunnel under the
Rail Road from the Eastern terminus of
Alliance Street to the Southern terminus of
Webb Street asked for further time which
was granted.

* Motion of Ellison seconded by Gray passed to 3rd reading the Resolution to improve that part of Freedom Street lying between the Pittsburgh Fort Wayne & Chicago Rail way and Market Street - including the Public square thereon. The yeas and nays being called resulted as follows yeas Beardsley Transue Probst Coates Ellison Gray yeas 6 Nays 0. The Mayor then declared the Resolution duly passed.

On motion of Gray seconded by Probst passed to second reading the Resolution to improve that part of Alliance Street lying between Arch Street and the west side of Mount Union Ave. On motion it was laid over till ^{next} regular meeting.

Moved by Gray seconded by Coates that an order be drawn in favor of Dr Doersell for \$750 that - being the ballance claimed due him for Medical service rendered Mr Condous child. Motion lost.

Motion of Gray seconded by Beardsley that an order be drawn for \$35.00 in favor of Mr Condow to pay Dr Saxon for medical service rendered his child. Carried.

Motion of Coates seconded by Transue that the sidewalk in front of Mr Linnis property on Park Street - be repaired. Motion carried.

Motion of Ellison seconded by Transue that the repairing of the ceiling in the Town Hall be referred to Building Committee. Carried.
