Minutes of last meeting read and approved. J. Williams offered his resignation as Councilman. On Motion of Coates seconded by Francis the resignation was accepted by the following vote yeas Morgan Probst Francis Coates Stebb yeas 5 nays 0

A communication from Geo Kelly was read stating that he would ~~perform the~~ Labor as ~~down~~ ~~car~~ ~~ter~~ for \$1.25 per day from April 1. to Nov 1. 1879 and the remainder of the year for \$1.00 per day. Motion of Francis seconded by Probst that the bid be accepted. Motion carried

Bond of Sol Berlin as night-Police with M M King and A. Raelter as sureties was read on motion of Stebb seconded by Francis accepted and ordered filed.

Bond of J. Johnson as night-Police with J. N. Ramsey and J. C. Craven as sureties was read on motion of Coates seconded by Francis accepted and ordered filed.

The Contract between M M Kerby and the Incorporated Village of Alliance for furnishing Coal ashes for the improving of Alliance Street on motion of Francis seconded by Morgan accepted and ordered placed on file
