* Report of Estimated Assessment -

To the Town Council of the Incorporated
Village of Alliance Stark County Ohio

We the undersigned freeholders of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Stark County - having been appointed by your honorable body to estimate the assessment of the cost of grading & paving curbing and otherwise improving that part of Freedom Street lying between the Pittsburgh Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad track and the north side of Market Street including the Public square thereon according to certain plans and specifications on file in the office of the Village Clerk on the lots and parcels of land abounding and abutting on said street between the points aforesaid do in pursuance of the provision of Section 508 of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Ohio an act to provide for the Organization and Government of Municipal Corporations passed May 9th 1879 respectfully report to your honorable body that the assessment on the lots and parcels of lands abounding and abutting upon said part of Freedom Street lying between the Pittsburgh Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad track and the north side of Market Street including the Public square thereon as estimated by us is three dollars and twenty seven cents upon each foot of frontage of each lot or parcel of land abounding ^{or} abutting on that part of Freedom Street ^{as shown in the first} ~~points~~ mentioned and upon the Public square the said estimate is twenty three
