



The Committee to whom was referred the Petitions asking for the walling and covering of the water course from Mechanic Street to Walnut Street reported unfavorably on motion the petition was laid on the table till next regular meeting.

Mayor Days Report for the month of May amounting to \$7.00 was read on motion of Gray seconded by Webb Report was accepted and ordered filed.

Monthly report of P. B. Garland for Materials used on side walks and crossing. was read

on motion accepted and ordered filed.

Proposition of A B Love for furnishing gasoline and lighting Street Lamps was read on Motion of Transue seconded by Webb accepted and ordered filed.

On Motion passed to 1st reading an ordinance to amend Sec 17 of an ordinance entitled an Ordinance to Provide for and regulate the Fire Department of the Village on Motion the Ordinance was laid over till next regular meeting.

Motion of Gray seconded by Transue that the City Solicitor be authorized to prepare an ordinance to amend the ordinance regulating the ringing of the town bell changing the time from nine o'clock until ten.

Moved by Coates seconded by ~~Probst~~ that the motion be laid on the table till next regular meeting.

Motion of Transue seconded by Coates that the Fire Committee be instructed to contract for the building of a cistern on Park Street near the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad Motion carried.

Motion of Probst seconded by Coates that a new walk be ordered down on the South side of Broadway from Liberty Street to the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad. Motion carried.

Motion of Coates seconded by Gray that a new walk be laid on the North side of Walnut from Park Street to Mt Union Street.

Motion of Probst seconded by Transue that the walks on the North side of Market Street be repaired and new walks laid where necessary, beginning at Arch Street and running west ~~till~~ Park Street Motion carried.

Motion of Webb seconded by Traverser that the walks on North side of East Liberty Street be repaired and new walks laid when needed beginning at Liberty Street and running East to Depot Street
