Alliance Ohio July 7 / 1879

Council convened in regular session Mayor Day presiding Roll called Present Morgan Probst Webb Trammie Coates Gray

Minutes of last meeting read and approved

Petition of Citizens on Walnut Street asking that the name of the Street be changed from Walnut to Prospect Street. On motion of Gray seconded by Trammie the Petition was referred to City Solicitor to report at next meeting

Monthly Statement of R B Garland for materials used on sidewalks and curbing was read on motion accepted and ordered filed

X A Resolution concerning the estimated assessment of the cost of improving Freedom Street between the Pittsburgh Port Hazen and Chicago Railroad and the north side of Market Street including the Public square thereon was read Moved by Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the Resolution to pass 2nd and 3rd reading and final passage seconded by Trammie and carried by the following vote yeas Morgan Probst Trammie Webb Coates Gray yeas 6 nays 0 The Resolution then passed 2nd and 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 6 nays 0 The Mayor then declared the Resolution duly passed

Estimate of work performed by the Austin Stone Company on Alliance Street during the month of June 1879 was read on motion accepted and ordered filed

It was moved and seconded that a special committee and city solicitor be appointed to investigate the claim of Nagle against the village of Alliance Mayor Day then appointed the following committee Gray Coates Webb

Motion of Coates seconded by Gray that the side walk and grade Committee be instructed to investigate the propriety of lowering the side-walk to grade on the South side of Broadway Street beginning on the East side of the W.B. Church and running North West to Park Street
