 for the month of Aug 1879 was read accepted
 and ordered filed

Mayor's Report of fines and licences col-
 lected during the month of Aug was read
 accepted and ordered filed

An Ordinance providing for extending
 the time of payment of Alliance Street
 Bonds passed 1st reading

Moved by Gray that the rules be sus-
 pended to permit the ordinance to pass
 2^d and 3rd reading and final passage seconded
 by Trauene and carried by the following over-
 yeas Morgan Probst Webb Coates Trauene
 Gray The ordinance then passed 2^d and
 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood
 as before yeas 6 nays 0 the Mayor declared
 the ordinance duly passed.

Motion of Gray that the Austin Flag-stone
 company have the privilege of closing
 Freedom Street between the Pittsburgh

At Wayne and Chicago Rail-Road and the Public square also from the South side of Public square and north side of Market street when in their judgment it becomes necessary in prosecuting the improvement of said Street seconded by Morgan and carried.

Motion of Coates seconded by Transue that the matter in regard to grade in front of Seacrests property on Columbia Street be referred back to grade Committee to investigate

Motion of Gray seconded by Transue that the Street Committee be instructed to have the well on Public square put in proper shape for the improvement.

At this juncture Mr Stobb asked to be excused for the remainder of the evening.

An Ordinance prescribing the widths of and Materials used for sidewalks on the East and West side of Public square in the incorporated village of Alliance passed 1st reading. Motion of Gray that the rules be suspended to permit the ordinance to pass 2nd and 3rd reading and final passage seconded by Coates and carried by the following vote yeas Morgan Probst Coates Francis Gray yeas 5 nays 0. The ordinance then passed 2nd & 3rd reading and vote on its final passage stood as before yeas 5 nays 0. the Mayor declared the ordinance duly passed. On Motion council adjourned.
